Support for Organic Certification and Registry in Ontario

The Christian Farmers Federation of Ontario (CFFO) is an Accredited Farm Organization representing the interests of over 4,000 farm families in Ontario.

The CFFO supports the proposal to legislate regulation governing the use of the term “organic” in Ontario. This will bring Ontario into alignment with the five other provinces who have implemented similar legislation. Creating a registry of certified “organic” products will further support the integrity of the Ontario organic food system.

Canadian consumers want to be able to make food choices based on their values and health needs. Consumer demand for organic products is growing in Canada. According to the Organic Council of Ontario, the organic market in Ontario is growing approximately 10% annually and is now worth \$1.4 billion per year. Legislated regulation of the use of “organic” will deepen public trust and benefit consumers by ensuring the integrity of organic production and products in the marketplace.

Legislation that creates consistency in the use of the term “organic” also supports producers by ensuring a fair playing field for all producers in Ontario and by ensuring better market access for Ontario organic producers. This will widen the opportunity for local organic producers to meet local demand.

Ontario has a strong and diverse food system, and organic farming is an important part of that overall diversity. Market demand demonstrates that Ontario consumers support this system of production. Government legislation to regulate “organic” will benefit both consumers and producers, and it will strengthen the Ontario agri-food sector as a whole.
